

Dispatch an Organization Overview

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If a dispatch requires the assistance of an agency, such as the police, fire department, or paramedics, you can dispatch an organization. When an organization is dispatched, a non-specific organization task with a **Responding** status is created, where it can be reviewed in the **Details** panel and managed in the **Dispatches** or **Organizations** panels. Organization tasks will appear in the **Organization Responses** section of **Tasks** in the **Details** panel.
