

Dispatch Administration Overview

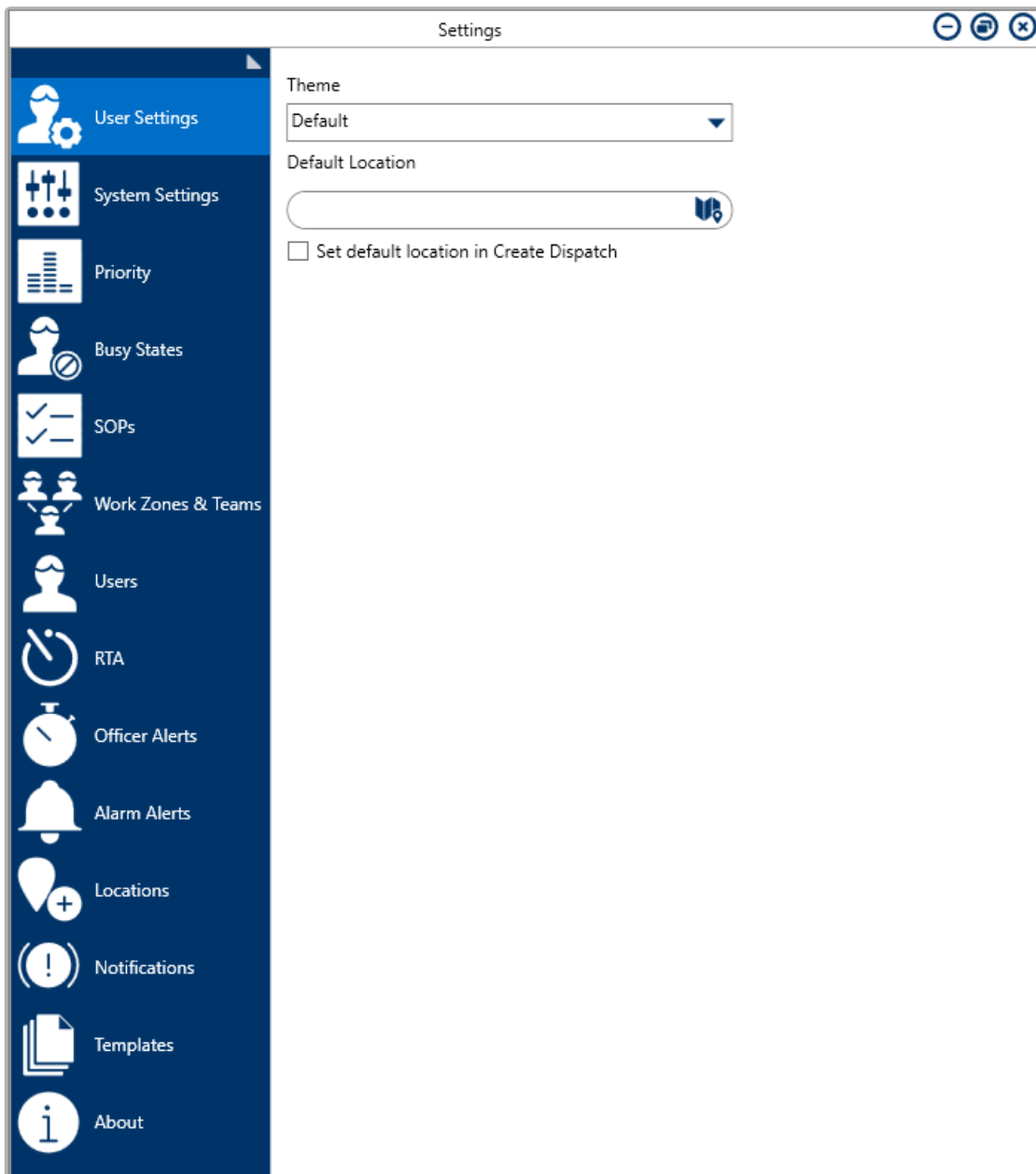
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To access the Dispatch settings, click the  **Settings** icon in the ribbon to open the panel. To view the names of the settings, click the  icon in the top-left corner of the menu. Note that users without administrative privileges can only access the **User Settings**, **Notifications**, and **About** settings.

Though most of the settings can be configured from Dispatch directly, certain components and settings are created and managed in Command Center, namely:

- Creation of all Dispatch user accounts;
- Dispatch reference data (i.e., Business Unit, Location, People, Organization, Item, and Activity Type objects).
- Most fields (e.g. Reported Date/Time, Priority, Request Type, Call Sign, etc.).

You can make changes to the settings at any time, provided the item you wish to edit is not currently linked to a record in Dispatch. Once valid changes are entered and validated in the settings, they're saved automatically by the application.
