

Manually Delete the 2.0 Folder

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
This article provides instructions on manually deleting the 2.0 folder to uninstall Dispatch, as well as instructions on deleting additional folder data (if needed).

To delete the 2.0 folder:

1. Close all Core and Dispatch-related processes.
2. Open **File Explorer**.
3. Enter the **C:\Users\[USERNAME]\AppData\Local\Apps** path into the address bar of **File Explorer** then press **Enter** on your keyboard.




[USERNAME] in the above path will need to be replaced with the user name of the currently logged in user.

4. If you don't see the **Apps** folder:
 - a. Open **Control Panel**.
 - b. Click **Appearance and Personalization > Folder Options**.
 - c. Click the **View** tab.
 - d. Under **Advanced settings**, select the **Show hidden files, folders, and**

drives radio button.

e. Click **OK**.

5. Right-click the **2.0** folder.

6. Click **Delete**.
