

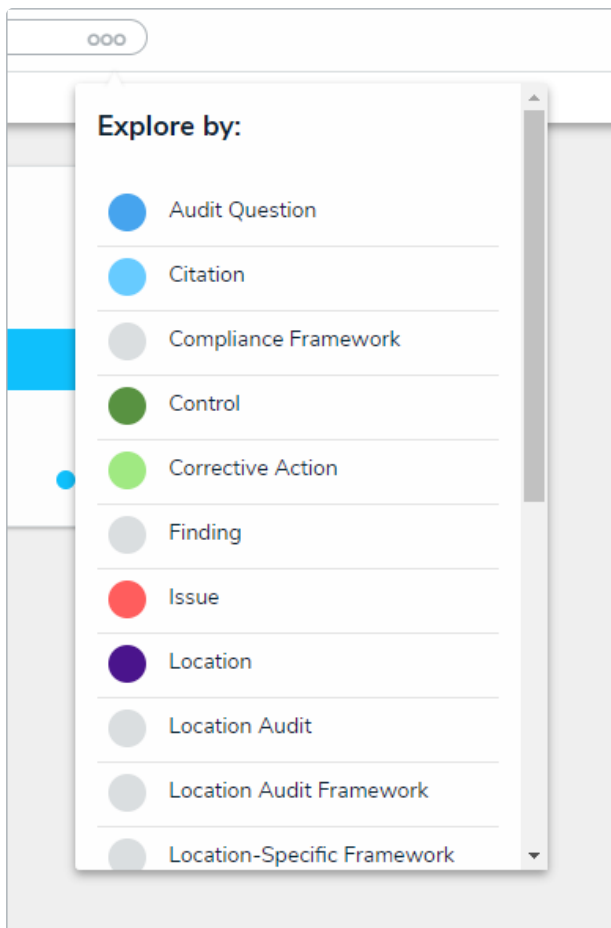
Search Security Risk Management by Object Type

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The following explains how to search by object type in Security Risk Management. Object type refers to the category of data collected. Security Framework Audit, Risk, and Location are all examples of object types. Searching by object type is an easy way to view all records of an object type. For example, you might want to view all locations to know which ones are available to be added to an incident.

To search Security Risk Management by object type:

1. Click the search text field in the nav bar, then click the  icon to display the **Explore By** menu.
2. Click an object type from the list to display its objects in the search results.



The Explore By menu. Clicking an object type in this menu will display search options.

3. From the **Search Results** page, use the filters in the **Filters** section to the left of the page to narrow down which objects are displayed. The following filters are available on this page for every object type:
 - **By Name;**
 - **By Assessment Type;**

- **By Dimension;**
- **By Description;**
- **By Unique ID; and**
- **By State.**
