User Account Requirements

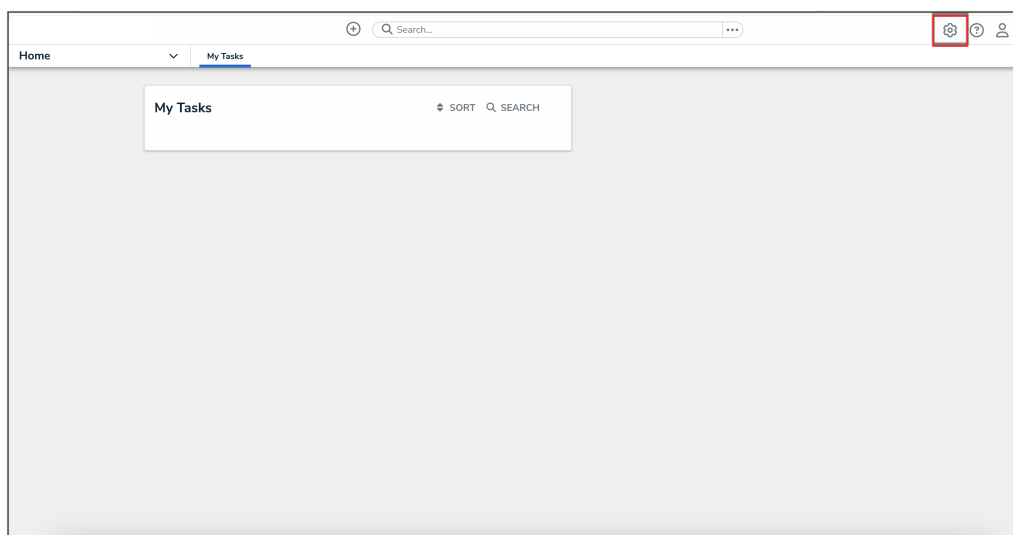
The user must have Administrator or to edit or delete object type relationships.

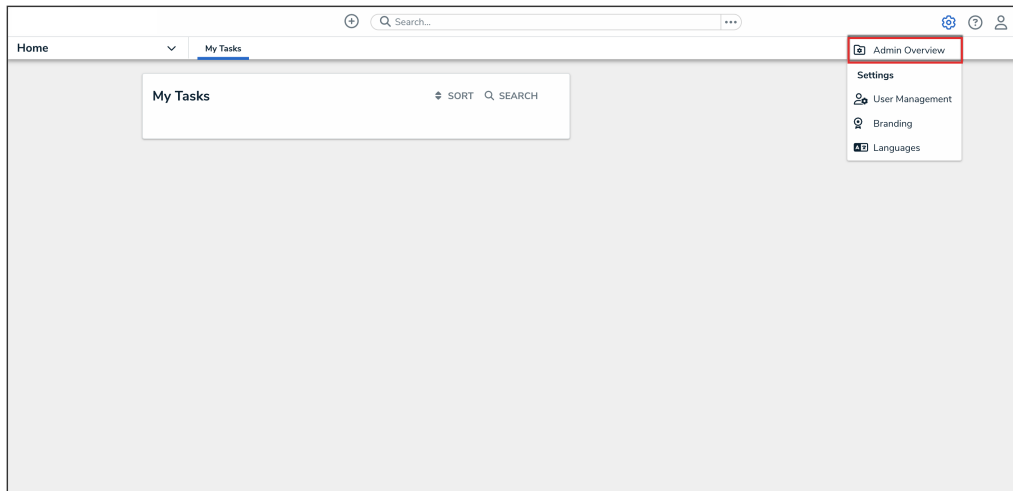
Navigation

1. From the **Home** screen, click the **Administration** icon.



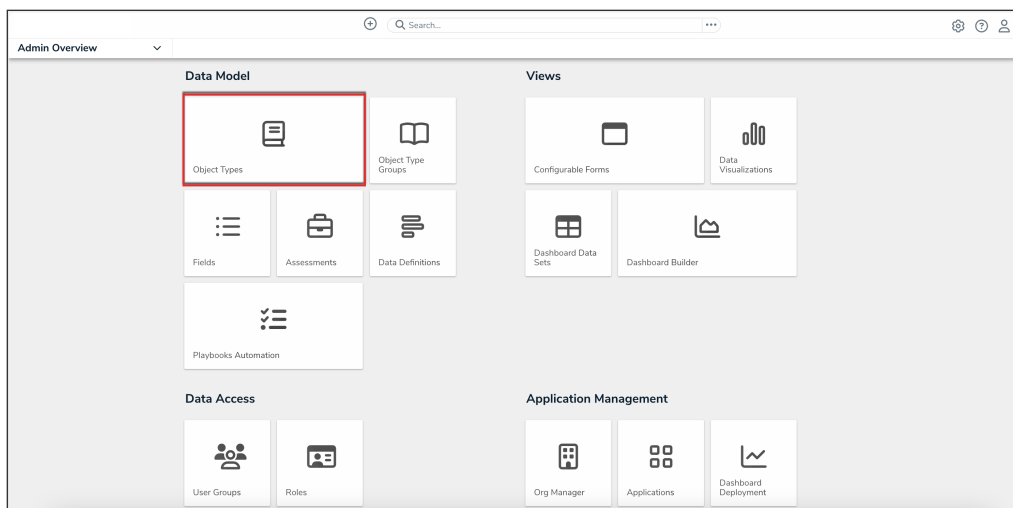
Administration Icon

2. From the **Administrator Settings** menu, click **Admin Overview**.



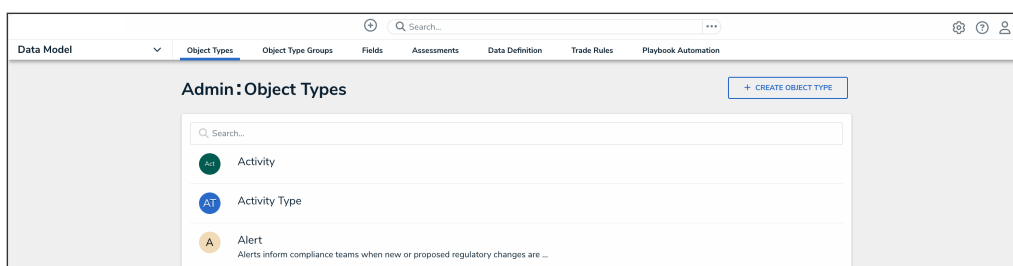
Administrator Settings Menu

- From the **Admin Overview** screen, click the **Object Types** tile under the **Data Model** section.



Object Types Tile

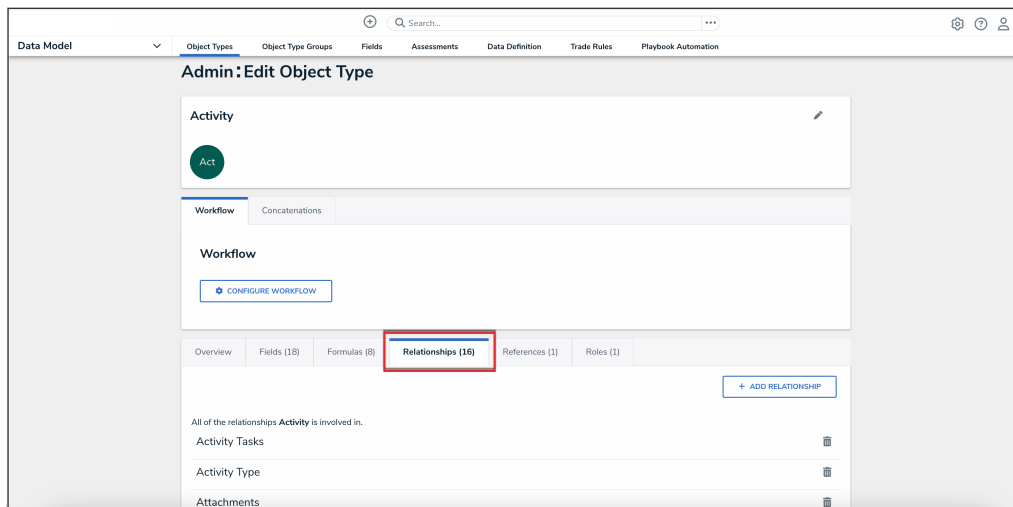
- From the **Object Types** screen, enter a keyword in the **Search** field to narrow the object types list and click the object type with the relationship you want to edit or delete.

- From the **Edit Object Type** screen, click the **Relationships** tab to find the relationship

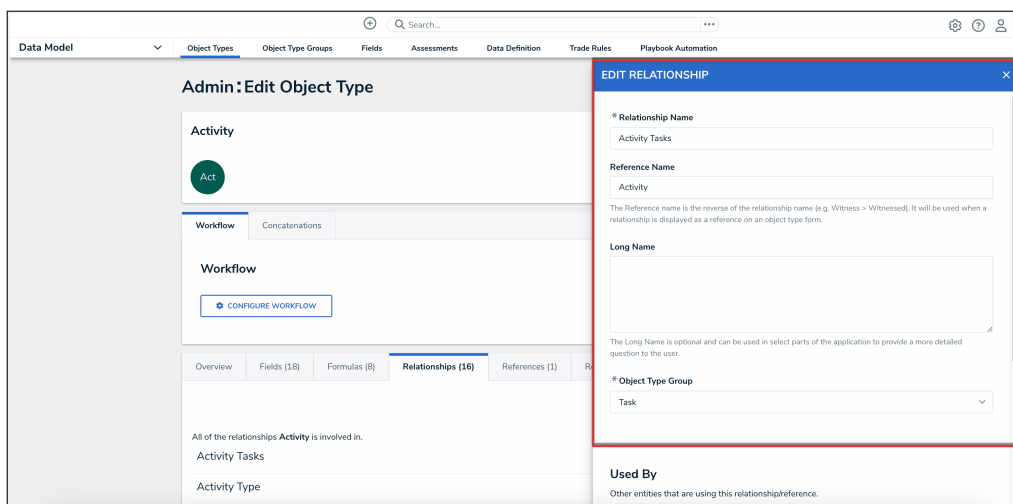

Relationships Tab

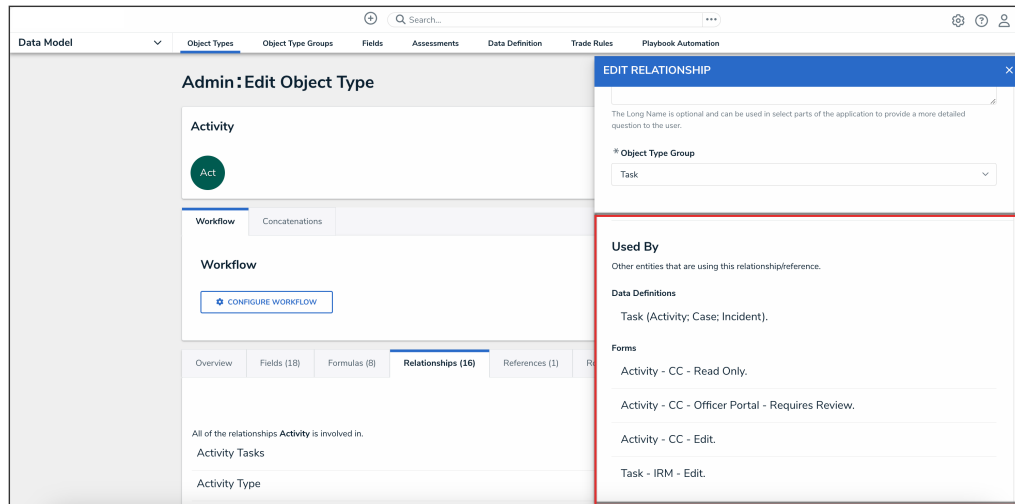
Editing an Object Type Relationship

1. From the **Relationships** tab, click the relationship you want to edit. From the **Edit Relationship** pop-up, you can edit a relationship name, reference name, long name, or object type group.

2. The **Used By** section lists which dashboard data sets, data definitions, forms (excluding relationships within a relationship table), formula variables, playbook automations, reports, and workflow actions use the relationship.



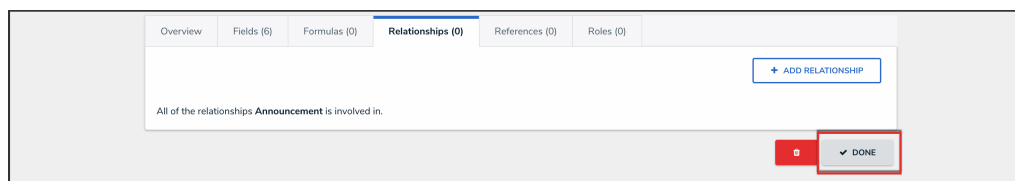

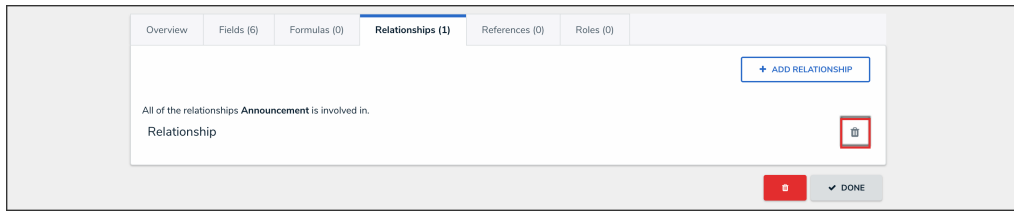
Deleting an Object Type Relationship



Note:

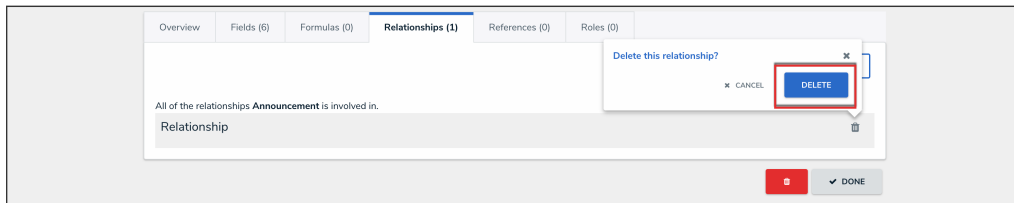
Relationships that are referenced by regular or n-depth formula variables, or relationships used by assessment anchors, data definitions, launched assessments, or mapped objects, cannot be deleted.

- From the **Relationships** tab, click the **Delete** icon beside the relationship you want to delete.



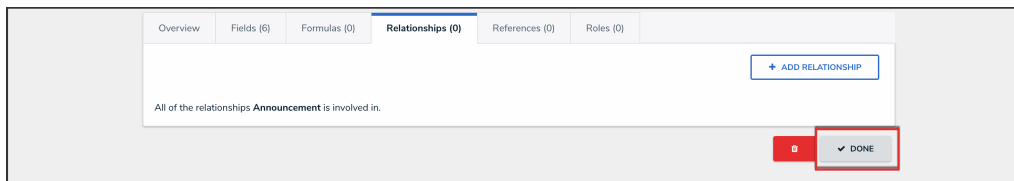
Delete Icon
